

Pearl "Pups"

A great way to leave a "lasting-impression" ... balloons "pop"!

Carry a "mini-Sharpie" to add a small mouth and 2-dots (eyes). At the beginning, say your Pup is trained; at the end, have it "sit-up" on its back-part (in your hand); then, tip your hand so it lands on its 4-feet and say "stay"; then, tip your hand so it falls and say "play dead". Some also palm an extra-bead and say "it's trained, but not house-broken" as they drop the "do-do" – or, squeeze a piece of moistened Kleenex.

Available in packages of 17-bead strands, or, rolls (un-cut) that will make hundreds-of-pups.

PRETTY PEARL POODLE

Made in 3 twists

Twist 1. Use your right hand first finger and thumb hold the four pearls under the first pearl and twist them together away from you. (See Drawing)

Twist 2. Skip a pearl and repeat the above. (See Drawing)

Twist 3. Skip a pearl and repeat the above. (See Drawing)

Now just straighten up the poodle aligning the head and tail.

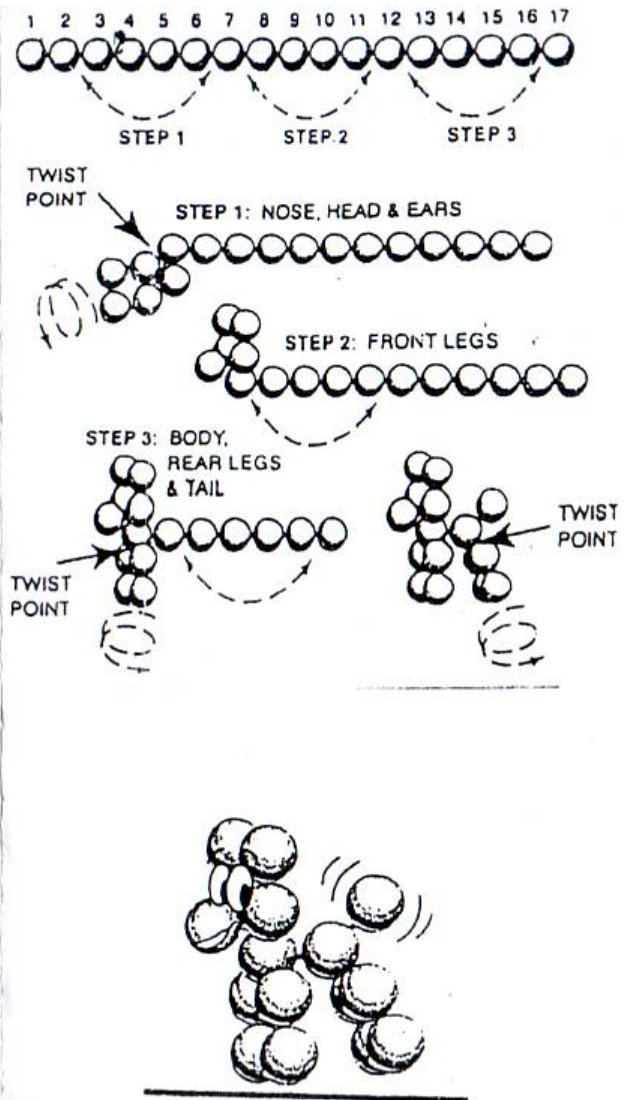
Once upon a time.. when I was growing up.
